Information: Prolonged hospitalisation and absence from productive with 1 year detention in psychiatric units. Patient has a known history of adverse reactions to many pharmacological medications (GP) yet treaters psychiatrics in 07 have ignored this and follow of ongoing high doses (Zyprexa reached 30mg). Psychiatrists will not alter treatment. Child had history of: pre-natal brain damage, epilepsy, hypoglycemic. Family has history of breast cancer. High use of multiple drugs on top of Zyprexa from Jan to Dec 07 and ongoing in detention in psychiatric facilities. Psychiatrists will not respond to requests to cease.

Drug exposure during pregnancy		schizophrenic patient became pregnant and at 6 weeks gestation all medication were ceased because the doctor feared teratogenic complications. She experienced paranoia and hallucinations after 2 weeks off her medication. Given oral chlorpromazine to treat symptoms and also received 7 days treatment with phenytoin. She continued to experience auditory hallucinations and wanting to harm her unborn child. While on chlorpromazine she experienced drowsiness, hypersalivation, cogwheel rigidity , postural hypotension, fainting and possible seizure. The baby was born via caesarian at 36 weeks and was unresponsive and small for age.
