Given oral chlorpromazine to treat symptoms and also received 7 days treatment with phenytoin. She continued to experience auditory hallucinations and wanting to harm her unborn child. While on chlorpromazine she experienced drowsiness, hypersalivation, cogwheel rigidity, postural hypotension, fainting and possible seizure. The baby was born via caesarian at 36 weeks and was unresponsive and small for
